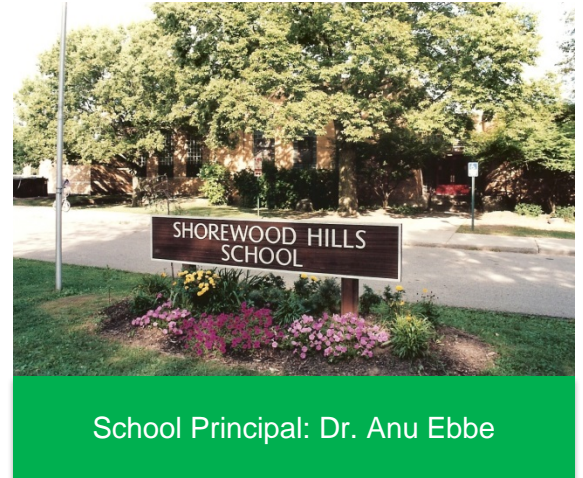

Shorewood Hills Elementary School is a National Blue Ribbon School. Only 0.5% of public and private schools in America earn this distinction.

Our success comes from embracing our diversity. To summarize our central educational philosophy: By valuing diversity we can optimally engage students, staff, and families in learning. This philosophy drives three key strategies that have led to the realization of student potential: (1) Consistently support a “welcoming” culture, creating a safe space for students, staff, and families; (2) Engage families, students and staff in leadership in ways that value diversity; and (3) Learn from diversity and differentiate learning, both curricular and extracurricular.

Strengths

We know that establishing caring and trusting relationships, and a sense of belonging throughout the school community is key to ensuring all students achieve their full potential. Therefore, we take a conscious and intentional approach to our school's climate and culture through learning from parent panels and student circles. Additionally, staff implements the Welcoming School Gender Spectrum Program, and Social and Emotional Curriculum, Second Step school wide.

Members of the school community are encouraged to build on strengths by taking risks and trying new approaches-Four years after being selected as one of the first pilot schools for 1:1 technology integration in classrooms, we launched a Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math (STEAM) pilot in REACH classes in 2017. We are excited to extend our technology learning so we can integrate this new learning in meaningful ways with our students.

In 2018, Shorewood School will be a pilot school for Advanced Learning. The purpose of this pilot program is to help support our school further reach and challenge students with advanced learning needs. Shorewood School is one of the four elementary schools selected for this pilot.

Progress

Our teacher teams met consistently to focus on reading, examining student data, planning lessons and reflecting on teaching practices. Teachers thoughtfully planned and implemented reading lessons across content areas to engage students in collaboration, creative thinking and problem solving. This included learning from books written by diverse authors and illustrators on a variety of topics.

Area for Growth

Our staff will build on last year's momentum and continue to design strong lessons across content areas. In 2018, we will engage in professional learning and family partnerships to implement a more rigorous math curriculum, Bridges.

Vision Connection

Our school supports MMSD's vision that all students acquire the skills and abilities needed to be successful, including a mastery of content areas, growth mindset, self-knowledge, creativity, wellness, interpersonal skills, confidence, cultural competence, and community connection. Through these skills and abilities, our students will graduate college, career, and community ready.

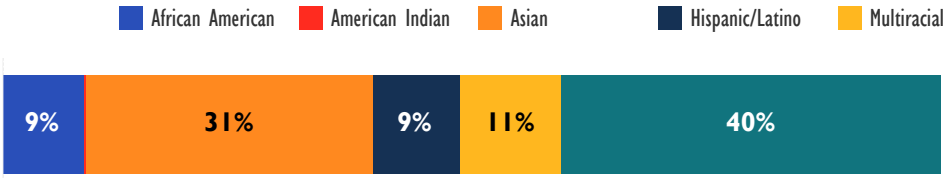

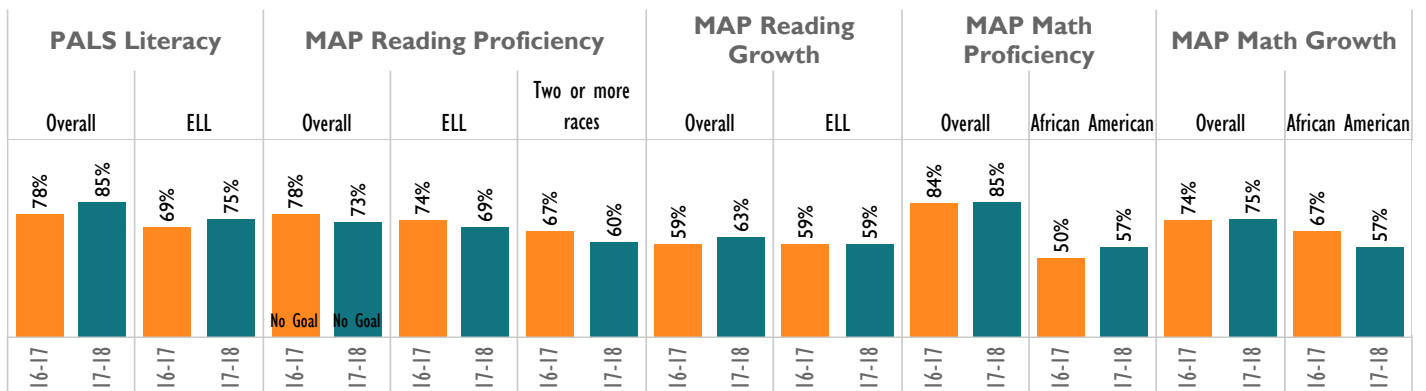

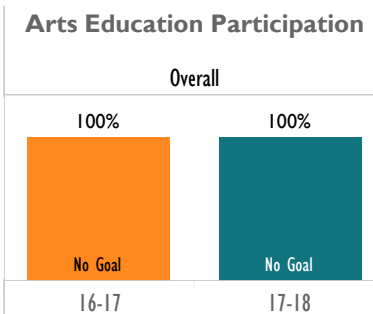
